- 3 Condition Over 14.3hh
- 4 Mountain & Moorland Small Breeds
- 5 Part Bred In-hand
- 6 Child Handler - Handler 12 years and under—no adults allowed in the ring,
handler must be competent to handle their pony with no outside assistance.
- 7 Handsome Horse - 14.3hh and over, no individual show
- 8 Coloured Open - Piebald, Skewbald, Roan, Spotted, Dun, Palomino, Cremello

Ring 1: Ridden Classes

- 17 Walk & Trot – walk & trot only
- 18 Ridden Veteran – Horse 15 years and over
- 19 Ridden Pony - 14.2hh and under
- 20 Lead Rein Pony –LR to be attached to the noseband only
- 21 Ridden Mare
- 22 Senior Ridden – 16 years and over, any bridle
- 23 Happy Partner pony – this is the only class LR competitors can enter off the
LR. Walk & trot only, rider 10 years and under
- 24 Most Promising Combination Junior – Rider 15 years and under
- 25 Cob Type

RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP (for classes 17 – 35) Split Junior / Senior

Championship qualification - All 1st placed SENIORS and all 1st & 2nd placed
JUNIORS qualify. Junior is any competitor 15 and under.

Classes are £6 per class for members, £8 for non-members, membership £15 per
person. Placings 1st – 6th, pre enter online or cash only on the day. No new members
after the July show, membership includes Presentation evening entry.

Refunds on the day will only be given if a horse presents lame. Pre entries can be
made up until the Friday before the show.

- 31 First Ridden - 12 years and under, snaffle bridle only
- 32 Ridden Coloured Open
- 33 Most Promising Combination Senior– Rider over 16 years
- 34 Lead Rein Equitation – Judged solely on the rider & relationship with the pony
- 35 Ridden Mountain and Moorland Open – Natural or pulled & plaited
